

Study in higher education anytime, anywhere

There are several ways to study online. Here, you can learn more about the different options for studying online in Finland.

Studying for a degree online

Higher education independent of time and place has become increasingly popular. It is now possible to complete a number of higher education degrees online for which the programmes are applied to in the joint application.

You can apply to both universities of applied sciences and universities in the joint application to higher education. The joint application is organised three times a year, twice in spring and once in autumn.

For the majority of study programmes, you can only apply in the 2nd spring joint application. The number of programmes available in the autumn application period is significantly lower.

Find out when the study programmes that interest you are available in the joint application. Some courses and modules are free of charge Free Tuition fee

Open UAS and Open University


Several universities of applied sciences offer non-stop courses and modules that are open to everyone and are available year-round. Some of these courses are conducted fully online.

The studies completed at **Open UAS** can be recognised if you continue your studies towards a degree at the same UAS. Before transferring to another UAS, you should check the equivalence of your studies at the new institution.

At **Open University**, you can study the courses belonging to university degrees in the same way as with Open UAS, regardless of your location, age or educational background. Almost all universities offer Open University courses. Open University courses follow the university's curricula, which means that the credits can later be approved as part of your degree studies.

You can enrol for Open UAS and Open University studies on the websites of the universities. Students are usually admitted in the order of enrolment. Some studies may have certain admission requirements with regards to prior learning or studies. Tuition fees vary depending on the institution. Some courses and modules are free of charge.

Path studies

Path studies refer to studying at a university of applied sciences together with a group of degree students through Open UAS.

Path studies are mainly first or second-year UAS studies. Path studies are arranged as daytime, online or multiform studies. After completing the path studies, students can apply as a degree student through separate application. There is a tuition fee for path studies.

There is a limited number of study places available for path students, which are mainly filled in the order of enrolment. Some path studies may have other application criteria, such as required previous studies (Master's degree programmes). In some degree programmes, admission to path studies requires the completion of a selection course, an advance assignment or a motivation letter.

Path studies are also a good option if you were not selected as a degree student in the joint application. Start higher education studies during upper secondary education. Free

Pathway studies

Pathway studies offer upper secondary school students the opportunity to begin pursuing higher education while still in upper secondary school or a vocational institution.

During pathway studies, students complete Open UAS studies online or on campus. After completing the pathway study programme and upper secondary education, students can apply for degree studies at a UAS through the open path separate application without an entrance exam.

Pathway studies provide a new route to higher education.
